To match changes in the student text (page 18); while the sacrifices of the Hebrews did not completely atone for sins, they did participate, in a real way, in the atonement that would be wrought by Christ. It is, therefore, more accurate to say that their sacrifices did not <i>fully</i> atone for sins.	2008 Reprint
3	Page 9, number 4	Replace when with if	Word choice change	2008 Reprint

To match changes in the student text (page 59); scandal is a lack of charity to our neighbor. The <i>greatest</i> lack of charity would be with respect to our relationship with God.	2008 Reprint

To match changes in the student text (page 62); this clarifies that man participates in God's wisdom by following God's plan for using the reproductive powers.	2008 Reprint
22	Page 51, number 4, lines 1-2	Replace If God creates the soul, what do the husband and wife cooperate with God to create? with God creates the soul. The husband and wife cooperate with God to create what?	The sentence was revised so that it does not include "if" with reference to God's creation of the soul. Since at this age students read in a very literal way, this change was made to avoid giving the impression that God does not always create the soul.	2008 Reprint
23	Page 54, number 5	Insert am to to read If I am to receive	Clarification; the original question may have implied that one is paid before work. The revised question makes it clear that one is paid for one's work.	2008 Reprint
24	Page 54, number 7	Replace Can you steal another person's ideas or work? with Is taking another person's ideas or work a form of stealing?	Clarification; the original question may have seemed to ask if it is possible to steal another person's ideas or work, which of course, it is possible to do.	2008 Reprint
25	Page 59, number 1	Insert What would be more prudent and charitable in this situation? after the end of the first question	The additional question and answer aim at helping the students to think about what to do if they find themselves in a situation where speaking the truth could be sinful.	2008 Reprint
26	Page 65, number 2, line 1	Insert or metaphors to read What Jesus speaking in riddles or metaphors when he said	The insertion was made to help students recognize the True Presence of Christ in the Eucharist and that his words were not merely metaphorical.	2008 Reprint
27	Page 67, number 2	Replace in person with visibly	Because Jesus' presence in the Eucharist is also his personal presence, the original question was unclear. The revision clarifies the distinction being made in the question.	2008 Reprint

38	Page 75, number 7, lines 1-2	Replace What are the three different white cloths that look like napkins called and how are they used? with What is the white linen cloth used to purify the vessels after Communion?	As the answer in the teacher’s manual indicates, this question is only asking about the purificator. There are not necessarily three purificators used at every Mass, so the question was revised to indicate a specific linen instead of the number of linens used.	2008 Reprint
39	Page 80, number 5	Replace What must you do first? with If you are in the state of mortal sin, what must you do before you receive Holy Communion?	Clarification of what the question is asking	2008 Reprint
40	Page 81, number 1	Replace he with it	Jesus had died before his body was taken from the Cross, and his soul had therefore departed from the body. It is thus more appropriate to refer to the body as “it” in this context.	2008 Reprint
41	Page 81, number 2	Delete 2. What did the apostles think?	The question was unclear because it was not specific about what it was asking. Moreover, the Scriptural account does not provide us with this information.	2008 Reprint
