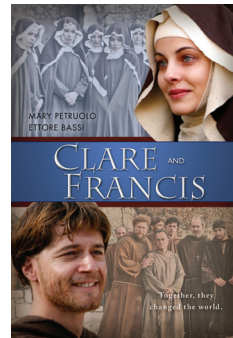


The Joyful Beggar

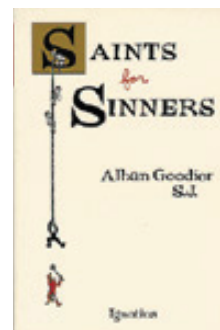


Francis and Clare, Saints of Assisi
