2	Page 16, directions, line 1	Replace say Yes or No to God with be good or bad	Because some of the questions below that are answered with “no” do not necessarily also imply saying “no” to God, it is more accurate to describe the actions as good or bad.	2008 Reprint
3	Page 16, number 2	Delete number 2	The answer to the question is a prudential matter that cannot be sufficiently answered with either yes or no.	2008 Reprint
4	Page 16, numbers 3-6	Change numbering of questions 3, 4, 5 and 6 to 2, 3, 4 and 5 , respectively.	Renumbering is needed after number 2 is deleted.	2008 Reprint
5	Page 18, line 1	Replace your textbooks with chapters four, five, and six	The change helps students identify where to look for help with the activity.	2008 Reprint
6	Page 19, first column, number 8	Insert hard to read work hard for food	The change is to emphasize that after the Fall Adam and Eve obtained food only by toil.	2008 Reprint
7	Page 21, number 4	Insert first and delete in us to read What is this first sin called?	Syntax correction	2008 Reprint
8	Page 25, number 4	Delete Did he? and insert In the end did he have to give him up?	The previous question was unclear in what it was asking. The change is intended to clarify the question’s direction.	2008 Reprint
9	Page 26, last row	Change the fourth letter from the right, S to D	The change completes “DAVID” in the word find.	2008 Reprint

10	Page 27, line 7	Replace second word blank with five smaller word blanks	Having the appropriate number of spaces is intended to help children find the correct answer.	2008 Reprint
11	Page 28, second section, number 1-7	Change numbers 1-7 to 4-10	The change will help students learn the proper order and number of the Ten Commandments.	2008 Reprint
12	Page 31, line 1	Insert and listening to him to read Prayer is our way of talking with God and listening to him.	The change emphasizes the two-way movement of prayer.	2008 Reprint
13	Page 31, line 4	Replace four with different	There are other ways to pray in addition to the four ways mentioned in the activity.	2008 Reprint
14	Page 31, line 2 in the lower portion	Replace for giving me my family with because You are all good	Adoration is directed to God for who he is. The example before the change would more aptly be described as thanksgiving. The new example makes the nature of adoration more explicit.	2008 Reprint
15	Page 33, paragraph 2, lines 2-3	Delete Each sin that we ___takes___away from our___.	The sentence was deleted because it does not specify what type of sin takes away grace from the soul, and was therefore imprecise.	2008 Reprint
16	Page 35, number 5	Replace Who asked with What angel came to	Because it could be said that both God and the angel asked Mary this question, the change is intended to direct students to the answer being sought.	2008 Reprint
17	Page 37, number 2	Insert besides Jesus to read Was anyone besides Jesus ever free from Original Sin?	Because the question is asking specifically about Mary and because Jesus was also free from Original Sin, “besides Jesus” was inserted to avoid any ambiguity.	2008 Reprint
18	Page 40, bottom of page	Replace Chapter 10 with Chapter 11	Typo correction	2008 Reprint
19	Page 49, number 3	Insert in our neighbor to read What does it mean to love God in our neighbor?	The question is more specific in order to obtain the prescribed answer.	2008 Reprint
20	Page 53, number 4	Replace payer with prayer	Spelling correction	2008 Reprint
21	Page 54, title	Delete 4 to read Kinds of Prayer	There are more than four ways to pray.	2008 Reprint
